Online classes are offered as Semester 1, Semester 2, and Yearlong classes. Some are offered at certain set times and others are available to be taken during any time slot. No early bird classes (before school) will be offered. See Mrs. Baker for online class offerings and scheduling. An agreement and fee in most cases are required in order to take an online courses. You are required to log-in daily during the scheduled class time. These classes are high school credit/grade and college credit/grade, just like the VHCC and Emory & Henry Dual Enrollment courses.

Study Hall is NOT a class option anymore and will ONLY be used at Principal/Counselors discretion, when all other options have been exhausted.
